**CITATION TO THE RESTRAINED PERSON:**

You are ordered to appear and show cause, if any, why this Temporary Protection Order should not be made Permanent. The next hearing is Wednesday, 10/21/2020 (date) 3:00 PM (time) at the court address above in Courtroom 1. If the Restrained Person fails to appear at this hearing, a bench warrant may be issued for the arrest of the Restrained Person and the Temporary Protection Order previously entered by the Court shall be made permanent without further notice or service upon the Restrained Person. This Temporary Protection Order expires at the conclusion of the Hearing date stated above unless continued to another date or made a Permanent Order of the Court.

**PROTECTION ORDER:**

The Court finds that it has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter: that MCCORKLE, GREGG (Restrained Person) constitutes a credible threat that an imminent danger exists to the life and health of the Protected Persons named in this action, and sufficient cause exists for the issuance of a Civil Protection Order.

The Court Orders that you, the Restrained Person shall not contact, harass, stalk, injure, intimidate, threaten, touch, sexually assault, abuse, or molest the Protected Persons named in this action, or harm, take, transfer, conceal, dispose of, or threaten harm to an animal owned, possessed, leased, kept or held by any protected party, or a minor child of any other party, or otherwise violate this Order. You shall not use, attempt to use, or threaten to use physical force against the Protected Persons that would reasonably be expected to cause bodily injury. You shall not engage in any conduct that would place the Protected Persons in reasonable fear of bodily injury.

5. Other Provisions.



On September 22, 2020 at approximately 0830 hrs, Aspen Officers were dispatched to the area of Replay Sports, 465 N. Mill Street, for the report of an assault. I responded and arrived a short time later. Upon my arrival I was initially unable to locate the reporting person, later identified as Trenton Harrison (DOB 8/17/73).

I'm familiar with Harrison and know that he's been having an ongoing spat with a co-worker at the Aspen Post Office where Harrison works. I'm familiar with these two subjects from previous complaints filed at the police department and know the other subject as Gregg McCorkle (DOB 9/8/72). I responded to the post office and spoke with Postmaster Reza Tehrani in an attempt to learn more information. Tehrani told me that there have been ongoing issues at the post office between Harrison and McCorkle that they've been dealing with internally. Tehrani confirmed that McCorkle was currently working and that Harrison was due to clock in at 0830 hrs for his shift.

I contacted McCorkle while in Tehrani's office. Also present with me was Aspen Officer Wolfgang Marshall. Below is the following information:

"Harrison was in the office at the time of the incident. He was in the office to speak to me about the incident and said that McCorkle had in fact snook his genitals at Harrison."

-McCorkle explained that over the last few days Harrison has been flipping him off. McCorkle added that Harrison has flipped him off on the post office dock, in passing while delivering mail, and in the Clark's Market parking lot.

-McCorkle stated that while he and Harrison were delivering mail in the area of Vine Street, Harrison suddenly swerved his vehicle at McCorkle while he was on foot. McCorkle said that it wasn't a close call but that he certainly did it intentionally to make a point.

-McCorkle said that he's tired of Harrison and that this morning (9/22/2020), McCorkle saw Harrison walking into work. McCorkle walked up to Harrison and confronted him about his behavior towards him. McCorkle explained to Harrison that they were off post office property and off the clock and essentially told them they should settle their differences.

-McCorkle said that Harrison stepped towards him and said "Or what sailor boy?" McCorkle added that he's a United States Navy veteran and that was the reason Harrison used that term towards him.

-McCorkle then grabbed Harrison by the shirt at which point Harrison lost his footing and tripped backwards. McCorkle said that he then guided Harrison down to the ground and "eased him over the fence." Harrison kept saying "Get off me." McCorkle said that he told Harrison "Don't fuck with me anymore. I'm sick of this shit." McCorkle said that he then let Harrison go and walked back to the post office.

After collecting a statement from McCorkle I responded to Aspen Velo, a bicycle shop located in the immediate area of where this altercation took place. I

spoke with the owner of the shop, Luke Wampler, and asked him if the video surveillance system is operation. Wampler told me that he believes that it works but that it's live-feed only and doesn't store footage. Wampler paid to activate the storage on the camera and told me he would contact me later in the day if he was able to retrieve footage. I received a phone call from Wampler's fiancée later that afternoon and she told me they had determined that they were unable to retrieve the footage retroactively.

On 9/23/2020 at around noon, I met with McCorkle outside of the Aspen Police Department. I served McCorkle with a municipal court summons (Summons #A18477) for assault and battery. I provided McCorkle with a court date on October 14, 2020 at 0900 hrs.

On 9/23/2020 I also spoke with Harrison by phone. I told Harrison that McCorkle was going to be cited for assault. Harrison told me that he had a black eye from this encounter and mentioned that there was damage done to his eye glasses. I directed Harrison to speak with the Municipal prosecutor to discuss the possibility of restitution for damage done to Harrison's property. Harrison provided me with pictures of his injuries and a written statement which I'll add into the case file.

While speaking with Harrison, I confronted him about the statements that McCorkle said Harrison had made during their encounter on 9/23/2020. McCorkle specifically mentioned the comment "bullshit boy" that Harrison made to McCorkle. I told Harrison that this was a serious matter and that he needed to stop before this escalates further and someone gets seriously injured.

On September 22, 2020 at approximately 0830 hours, I, Aspen Police Officer John Woltjer responded to an assault in the area of 465 N. Mill St. located in the City of Aspen, County of Pitkin, State of Colorado. Dispatch aired that a male (Trenton Harrison DOB 08/17/73) was just assaulted by a fellow employee (Gregg McCorkle DOB 09/08/76) and that Harrison was still laying in the parking lot of Replay Sports. It should be noted that Harrison and McCorkle both work for the Aspen Post Office. Officer Turner and I drove to the location but did not initially find Harrison because he was actually in front of the business Aspen Velo. Officer DelGrasso later found Harrison laying on the ground because he wanted officers to see how the event happened. Officer Turner and I then joined Officer DelGrasso and Harrison. Harrison was just beginning to get off the ground and I noticed his phone was broken on the ground and he stated his sunglasses were damaged. Harrison told Officer DelGrasso that he was walking to work while looking down at his phone and felt a "presence" in front of him. He looked up and saw McCorkle walking towards him. Harrison then stated McCorkle pushed him and he fell face first on the ground. Harrison then stated he did not see McCorkle's hands or anything else that would indicate he had hit Harrison.

Officer DelGrasso, Officer Turner, and I then spoke to Trenton Harrison and Gregg McCorkle. Harrison and McCorkle have had a long time feud and that Trenton had asked both of them to stay away from each other. Trenton stated that he had heard that Harrison has been flipping off McCorkle lately and that upsets McCorkle. Trenton also stated that he believes Harrison can at times exaggerate events. McCorkle then joined us and stated that he did approach Harrison on the morning of 09/22/20 to speak with him about their feud. McCorkle made it a point to speak with Harrison off of the post office grounds and that is how they ended up in front of Aspen Velo. McCorkle stated when he began to speak to Harrison, Harrison got into his face and called him a "sailor boy" mocking McCorkle's service in the US Navy. McCorkle took offense to this and said when Harrison said this, it escalated the conversation. Harrison stated he grabbed McCorkle by the front of his shirt. Harrison then tripped over the fence and McCorkle "guided" him to the ground. McCorkle stated he never hit Harrison. During this conversation I looked at McCorkle's hands and did not notice any redness or bruising that would indicate he had hit Harrison.

After some time I left the post masters office to meet Officer DelGrasso and Harrison outside the post office. After McCorkle had left the post masters office, Officer DelGrasso, Harrison, and I then entered. Trenton stated Harrison and McCorkle could return to work with the caveat they were not to contact each other. Officer Turner and I then went to Aspen Velo to see if their camera system was working. We spoke to the owner who stated the camera system does not store recorded video. It was decided that McCorkle would be written a municipal summons for the event, Officer Turner later completed this. I completed a non custody booking for McCorkle in Spillman.

Aspen Police Officer Seth DeGrasso

On 9/22/20 at approximately 4:30am all Aspen City Units were dispatched to an Assault that was reported to have occurred in the parking lot of Replay Sports located at 465 N Mill in the City of Aspen, County of Pitkin, State of Colorado. Reporting party, later to be determined as Aspen Post Office employee Trenton Harrison [DOB 8/17/73], stated that coworker Gregg McCorkle [DOB 9/8/76] had just assaulted him and he is laying on the ground in the parking lot.

The medics were dispatched to the location and asked to stage.

Aspen Police Officers Ryan Turner, John Wolinger and I responded to the location.

Officer Wolinger went to the front of the building and saw Trenton Harrison lying on the ground.

Trenton Harrison was laying on the ground with his back to the building. He was in the parking lot in front of Aspen Velo and Pappy Smith sidewalk, right near the split in the fence. His phone was out of the case and his glasses were on the ground as well. He had some dirt on the right side of his face, and a small abrasion on one of his right knuckles.

Harrison refused medical treatment, but the medics had arrived on scene so they checked him out. He was cleared medically, noting soreness to his left hip, right eye area, and that he may have hit his head.

When asked what happened, Harrison told me:

- He and McCorkle had been having issues with one another for about a year.
- He was accused of given McCorkle the finger just one day before this incident. He denied he did so.
- He was walking to work at the post office on this day. He was looking down at his phone when he felt a person walking toward him.
- He looked up and noticed the person to be McCorkle.
- Unprovoked, McCorkle grabbed him and pushed him over the fence. He then slapped the phone out of his hand and slapped him numerous times in the head as he was standing over him. Harrison also believed he was punched once in the head.
- He wanted McCorkle charged for what he did.

I asked Harrison numerous times if he said anything that could have provoked McCorkle. He said no.

I then took Harrison to the Post Office to the Post Master's office. There I learned that Harrison has been less than truthful with his employer about what has been going on with McCorkle.

Officer Turner was going to review surveillance video from Aspen Velo that may

have captured the incident and then proceed with the case. (Unfortunately the video at Aspen Velo doesn't record.)

I learned that McCorkle claimed that he went to confront Harrison about what had happened the day before, and McCorkle called him a "sailor boy". (McCorkle is a Navy veteran.) (See Turner and Woltjer's reports.)

Harrison would later admit to Turner that he did call McCorkle a "Sailor boy", however only after he was pushed to the ground.

McCorkle was given a municipal summons for assault by Officer Turner, and Harrison was told to refrain from the childish behavior between them.

## Greg McConkle Assault 9/22/20

September 22nd, approximately 8:25am I was walking to work (Post Office) on Puppy Smith Road in front of Aspen Velo.

I was walking and looking down at my phone when I sensed a person walking toward me on the sidewalk. I looked up so as not to run into the passerby, and say good morning perhaps, to be surprised by two hands grabbing my jacket at the chest. I tried to stand ground and resist the force pushing me back. I was shoved into the short wooden fence in front of the Velo bike shop and fell over the fence grabbing on to the person shoving me. I landed flat on my back, which knocked the wind out of me. My head hit the concrete parking strip. It was then I realized that the aggressor was my co-worker Greg McConkle. Mr. McConkle put a hand of my diaphragm to support his upper body, further complicating my breathing attempts. My feet were still on the fence, my back pinned flat on the concrete, still trying to catch my breathe. Mr. McConkle started screaming violently in my face...

"We are off the clock and I'm not in uniform so this is outside of work"

The next few moments or minutes were traumatic and fearful so my recollections of the following events might not be sequential.

I do remember being slapped (maybe 3 or 4 times) in the face. My glasses were slapped off my face (resulting in scratched lens). I recall a fist punch to my right eye (which swelled up as the day progressed). I recall Mr. McConkle grabbing my phone from me and tossing it aside. I distinctly remember Mr. McConkle saying to the effect ...

"Don't you fuck with me motherfucker"

"I own you!"

"Do you understand me?"

"I will end you motherfucker!" (is this a threat against my life?)

The last statement scares me as Mr. McConkle went out of his way, with obvious premeditation to intercept me with the intention to harm. This is not the first threat or assault toward me by Mr. McConkle. He has mentioned his gun collection on our Post Office workroom floor at least once. Mr. McConkle coincidentally is the mailman for my home. He has made one inappropriate comment to my wife and had another uncomfortable confrontation with her in our backyard concerning my dog. He admitted to "watching to see what we were doing" in a previous incident at work.

I do not feel safe around him at work due to previous threats and assaults. Now I feel unsafe walking to work without being ambushed and attacked. So I am deeply distressed about the safety of myself and my family at our home.

I do not recall the retreat of Mr. McConkle from atop me or his return to the Post Office. I only remember reaching for my cellphone at calling 911 at 8:28am. I decided to lay as I was left by Mr. McConkle, with my feet still caught up on the fence, my back to the concrete, and my head supported by the concrete parking strip until Police arrived.

I recall speaking to Seth DelGrasso. I recall being checked by the Ambulance crew and registering a higher than normal blood pressure (140/90 ?) and heart rate (100+bpm). I recall feeling confused, scared, and having shaky hands. I may have walked to the Post Office escorted by Officer DelGrasso but I am unable to recall this journey clearly. I remember being in my PostMaster's office, with 2 or 3 police officers, and discussing Amazon packages (?). I remember being told I was going to be transferred to Carbondale Post Office for a week, which confused me and upset me. I recall being escorted by the Postmaster to my case in the office and told not to clock in. The approximate time was 9:45. Then I worked until 7:40pm.

Greg McConkle Assault 9/22/20

Throughout the day swelling under my right eye and left side lower lip continued. Pain on the orbital bone under my right eye. Left jaw felt bruised and some swelling under the left side bottom lip. Right hamstring and right distal calf were achy and sore and stiff throughout day. Left quadricep felt bruised. Abrasion on the right hand. Bruising and slight swelling on the left palm. Headache increased throughout the day, requiring breaks due to inability to focus on small letters and numbers.

Emotional stress. Crying. Mental stress. Depression. Feelings of hopelessness, imprisonment, psychological torture, paranoia, and fear.
