An unknown person unlawfully entered the victims fenced yard, once in the yard property was damaged. This occurred in the 600 blk of W. Colorado Ave. Damage is less than \$1000.

On 12/04/10 at 1344 hours I was dispatched to a report of a burglary. I spoke with the victim, Jamie Porta, who said sometime between 2100 hours on 12/03 and 1130 hours on 12/04 someone had come into her yard. She said there were bloody hand prints on the outside of her house and a panel on her window swamp cooler had been removed and left in the front yard.

I responded to the scene and took photographs of the scene. They were later booked into evidence. There were some bloody smears on the outside of her house and the panel was removed, but it did not look as if the person who left the hand prints tried to enter the house. There was also a small gate on the west side of the house which had been damaged, and some fencing pulled out of the ground(chicken wire) as if someone had tripped over it. Total damage is less than \$50.

I spoke with Jamie who said her neighbors had told her the person responsible was named [Contr] and he had blue hair. I contacted her neighbors at [Contrary to public] They identified themselves as [Contrary to public] [Contrary to] They said they had a birthday party the night before which was crashed by 5-6 kids who aren't from the neighborhood. They told the kids to leave, and had problems with them all night long. [Contra] said one of them broke out a small rear window on their house. They said the person who was in Porta's yard was named [Contr] and he had short hair, was maybe 1/2 Hispanic and lived on 30 Rd. [Contra] hangs out with a [Contrary to public] who has blue hair. That was all they said they knew about the person.

I was unable to find [Contrary to public] in our files.
